


And finally, Mary Han-




Upcoming Changes



In the very near future we will have a whole house generator installed at our Nestucca House group home. This generator will be similar to what we have at our Madrona House. At 29,000 watts, this generator will be capable of powering all of Nestucca House during times of emergencies resulting in power loss. The cost of this project is \$30,000 and was made possible by community contributions, and grants from the Samuel S. Johnson Foundation, and the Collins Foundation.



On July 1 we will implement a **new financial and payroll software program**. This new program will be more suitable to the type of operation that Marie Mills Center is, and is less costly to maintain. Additionally, the new program will provide much flexibility in its use and be much more user friendly. Currently our financial office is working hard to get ready for this changeover.
